Document digitization for road freight transport

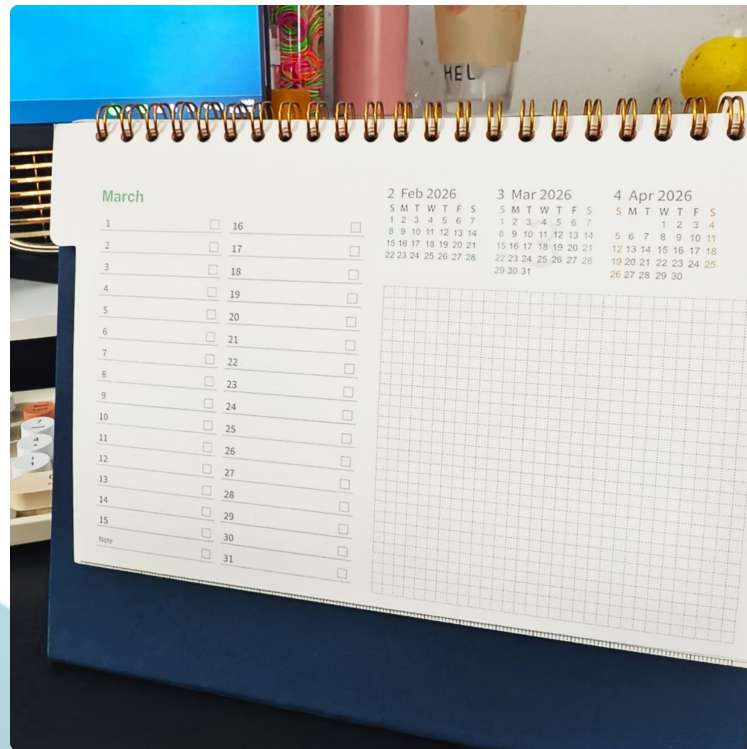
Road freight transport is moving away from paper-based management toward digital, traceable, secure documentation prepared for the new regulatory framework. Traxain helps carriers, shippers, logistics operators and consignees take that step with a flexible, integrable solution designed for real operations.

Regulatory change in Spain: October 2026

From 5 October 2026, the administrative control document required for public road freight transport in Spain must be digital.

Law 9/2025 on Sustainable Mobility entered into force on 5 December 2025 and establishes a ten-month period for companies to adapt their processes. The objective is not to replace paper with a PDF, but to ensure that the documentation is available, verifiable and can be presented during inspections.

Companies that are not prepared before the deadline may face difficulties during transport inspections and audits.



Control document, consignment note and eCMR: key differences

Digital Control Document



Mandatory administrative document for national transport. Digitization required from Oct. 2026.

Consignment note



Contractual document agreed between shipper, carrier and consignee; serves as proof of transport conditions.

eCMR



Electronic version of the international CMR. Digital management with traceability and storage.



THE PLATFORM

What Traxain is

Traxain is a platform for digitizing road freight transport documents. It allows companies to create, manage and store eCMR, electronic CMR, digital consignment notes and control documents from a single solution.

Creation and management

eCMR, electronic CMR, digital consignment note and control document in one unified platform.



Digital signature

Electronic signature for shippers, carriers and consignees in every operation.



Full traceability

Searchable files with complete history, evidence and change control.



Native integration

API designed to connect with ERP, TMS and internal systems without duplicating work.



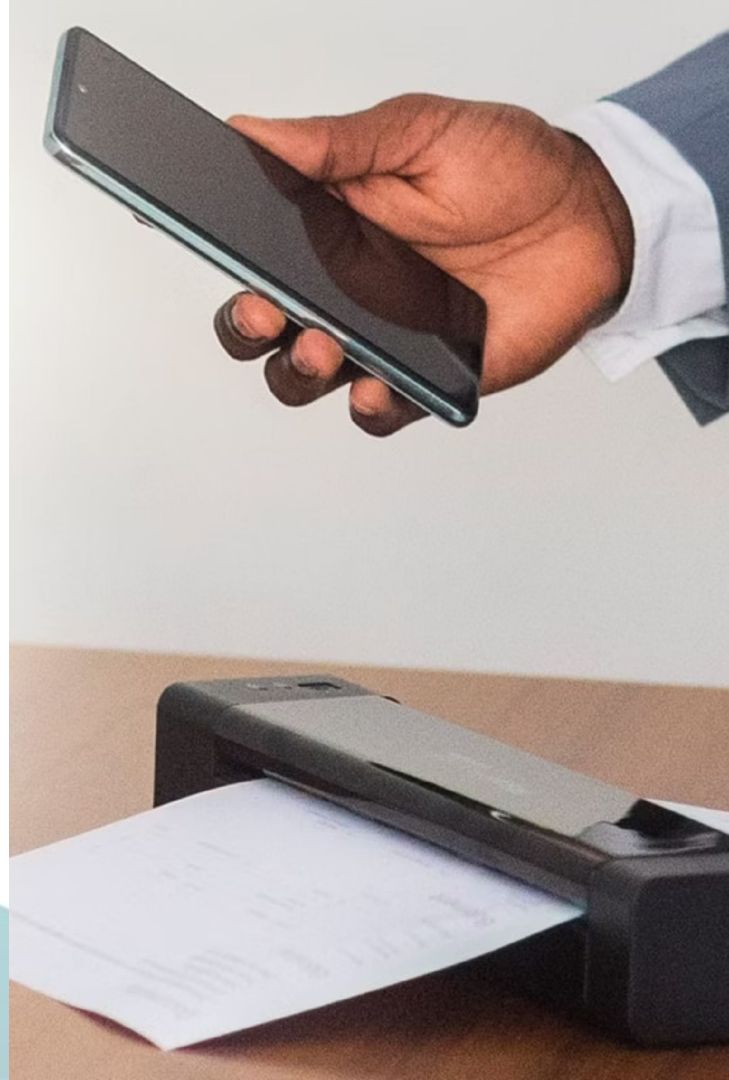
Traxain's two solutions

Solution 1: native eCMR

Create and manage digital CMR documents from scratch, covering the full document lifecycle of each operation. Guided creation, validation of key fields, digital signature and file-level traceability. Shippers, carriers and consignees work on the same document base, reducing errors and improving coordination.

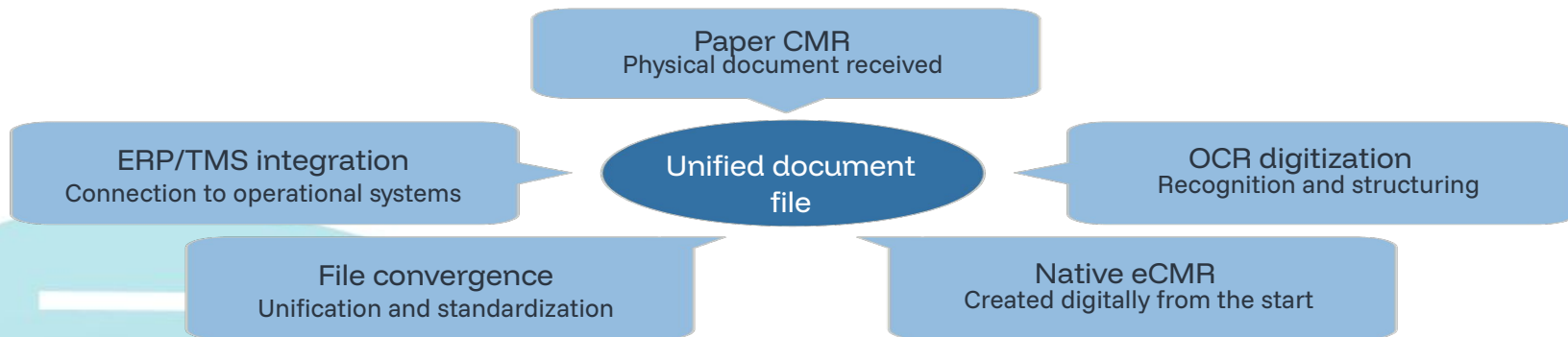
Solution 2: digitization of paper CMR

Convert paper CMR documents into usable digital documentation. The user uploads a photo or PDF, extracts key fields, reviews the data and links the document to a specific operation. The value lies in transforming that document into searchable, traceable information that is useful for traffic teams, administration and management.



From paper to structured data: flexibility for real operations

Paper creates lost documents, delays and reading errors. With Traxain, each document is linked to a digital file searchable by sender, consignee, date, route or reference.



Traxain does not force companies to change their entire operation at once. The platform enables a phased transition, adapting to companies whose customers, routes and branches progress at different speeds.

Integration with ERP and TMS

The Traxain API connects with existing systems to synchronize document statuses, create operations and maintain data continuity without duplicating work.

Security and change control

Each operation keeps its history: who creates, modifies or signs the document, which fields change and which evidence is attached. This is especially relevant for inspections, audits and claims.

Voice-based field editing

On the road, typing is not always convenient. Traxain includes the ability to edit fields and comments by voice, making it easier for drivers to update information without stopping their activity. This is especially useful at pickups, deliveries, incidents, goods observations, waiting times or comments linked to a specific phase of the trip.

Less friction

No need to type while on the road or at the loading dock.

Greater agility

Information reaches traffic teams and administration sooner.

More real-time data

Better operational visibility for decision-making.

Domestic clients — Spain

Traxain helps companies prepare for the transition to the mandatory digital control document before October 2026.

The eCMR facilitates collaboration between shippers, carriers and consignees in different countries. The eFTI Regulation establishes that European authorities must accept electronic data through compliant platforms; full application is set for 9 July 2027.

Phased implementation

Traxain enables transport documentation to be digitized progressively, without disrupting daily activity. Each phase delivers immediate value and prepares the next one.

Phase 1: Assessment

Identify which documents are used, where they are generated, who signs them and how they are archived.

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Phase 2: OCR digitization

Upload photos or PDFs of paper CMR documents, extract fields and create a traceable file.

Phase 3: Native eCMR

Create digital documents from the start with validated fields, signature and traceability.

Phase 4: Integration

Connect Traxain with ERP, TMS or internal systems to automate workflows.

Phase 5: Optimization

Add change control, voice editing, indicators and audit processes.

Document digitization in transport is no longer a future issue. In Spain, October 2026 marks a turning point. In Europe, progress toward the acceptance of electronic information confirms a clear direction: less paper, more data and greater traceability.
